“We feel like we are living in a new home, we can’t believe this is really our house. We absolutely love it...”

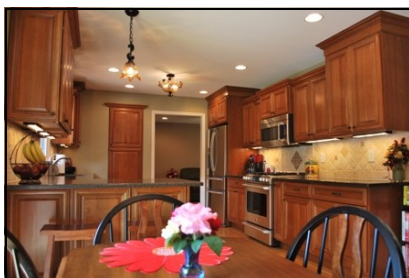
Joe & Dorothy W. – Joliet, IL
